Q. What exactly is the Triangle Alano Club?

A. The Triangle Alano Club (TAC) is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation dedicated to serving individuals and families who are recovering from the disease of alcoholism.

Q. Is the TAC and AA the same thing?

A. No! The Triangle Alano Club is not affiliated with the programs of Alcoholics Anonymous or Al-Anon.

Q. So what exactly does the TAC do?

A. The TAC provides a comfortable facility for AA, Al-Anon and Alateen groups to conduct over thirty meetings each week. The club also provides meeting space for special events such as workshops, speaker meetings and book study. The TAC also has an active social committee that plans events such as potluck dinners, dances, picnics, murder mystery parties, and bowling nights.

Q. Do I have to be a member of the TAC to attend meetings?

A. No. Anyone may attend any of the AA, Al-Anon or Alateen meetings held in the TAC meeting room, however, only TAC members and their guests may use the Member's Lounge.

Q. Do I need to be a TAC member to attend the social events.

A. It depends. A few social events are for members only and these will be so noted in the flyers and posters announcing the event, however, the majority of events welcome both members and non-members. For events that have an admission cost, frequently TAC members will receive free or reduced admission while non members will pay a little more.

Q. Are children welcome at the TAC?

A. Some of the meetings held at the TAC allow children and many of the TAC sponsored social events welcome children. If you bring

a child to a meeting at the TAC please be certain that the meeting welcomes children first. Children should be kept with you and quiet at all times so that others attending the meeting will not be distracted. *Under no circumstances are unsupervised children allowed in the Member's Lounge.*

Q. Why become a member of the TAC?

A. Membership dues are just one of the ways the TAC makes the money it needs to keep the doors open and provide its services to the members of AA, Al-Anon and Alateen. TAC members receive their own coffee mug and have access to the Member's Lounge which has a large screen TV, stereo, games, pool table, and comfortable seating. TAC members also may attend some social events for free or discounted cost. TAC members may serve on the Board of Directors, vote on issues concerning the club and serve on various committees.

Q. What are the TAC membership requirements?

A. Any current member of AA with 90 days of continuous sobriety and any Al-Anon/Alateen member with 90 days of active participation in these programs are eligible to become TAC members.

Q. Are my TAC dues tax-deductible?

A. No. Dues paid to the TAC are not tax deductible however, monetary donations made to the TAC are and a receipt will be provided to any donor.

Q. How do I join the TAC?

A. Joining is easy. Just fill out the membership form provided on the back of this leaflet and either mail to our post office box or drop in the gold box along with your dues payment. Please allow a couple of weeks for your mug to be created and placed on the back wall of the Member's Lounge. Monthly members will receive a dues reminder in the mail each month.
